

## General Hire Terms



1. The Cabin/Caravan may only be occupied by the number of persons mentioned in the Contract. A valid camping pass is obligatory and must be left with the Camp Manager during the stay.
2. During the hire period, the Hirer is responsible for the hired unit and liable for damages to the Cabin/Caravan or its equipment. Any damages should be reported immediately to the Camp Manager so as to be paid prior to departure.
3. The Hirer is responsible for cleaning of the hired unit. On departure the Cabin/Caravan as well as the equipment should be left in the same clean state as on arrival. Any necessary cleaning can be made at the Hirer's expense.
4. The Camp Manager assumes no responsibility as regards the occurrence of pests (ants, insects, earwings, wasps etc.) in or by the Cabin/Caravan.
5. The Camp Manager assumes no responsibility for suddenly occurring damages (installation failures and leaks, choked pipes, etc.), but will take care that repairs are made as soon as possible after he has been notified.
6. The Camp Manager must be notified of any other complaints within 48 hours after check-in. Complaints received later (e.g. after check-out from the Cabin/Caravan) are rejected. In these cases the Hirer cannot claim damages, price reductions or repayment of parts of the hire charge.
7. –
  - a. If a rental agreement is cancelled by the Hirer up to 2 months before the start of the rental period, the Camp Manager reserves the right of charging a cancellation fee of 10% of the total charge for the rental period plus an amount of indemnity, which will be set at the price for one day and night at a minimum.
  - b. In the event of cancellation by the Hirer later than 2 months before the start of the rental period, but sooner than 2 weeks before the start of the rental period, the Camp Manager reserves the right of charging 50% of the total price for the rental period including overnight fees.
  - c. In the event of cancellation by the Hirer later than 2 weeks before the start of the rental period, the Camp Manager reserves the right of charging the total price including overnight fees.
  - d. If the Camp Manager succeeds in re-renting the objects, in whole or in part, within the rental period, the amount obtained will, of course, be reimbursed less the deduction of the cancellation fee mentioned under a).
8. If the Contract is cancelled because of serious illness, serious injury or death of the Hirer, his spouse/cohabitor, children, parents or parents-in-law, as confirmed by a doctor's certificate, the hire charge already paid will be refunded less a fee of DKK 75,00.
9. The camping regulations and the rules in force on camping sites approved by the Danish Camping Board are to be observed by following the Camp Manager's instructions.
10. All amounts quoted include 25% VAT. Subject to charge in VAT and other taxes.
11. Any disagreement between Camp Manager and Hirer is to be settled under Danish rules of law. Legal actions can only be brought before the Court of Skanderborg, which is the venue selected.
